A refugee applicant's child can receive ¥100,000 without the child's "resident certificate."

[Example 4] In the Case of a Refugee Applicants' Child

- Parent(s) applied for refugee status and have a longer-than-three month status of residence.
- The parent(s) can receive the special cash payment (¥100,000) 4
- A child (baby) was born. A refugee application was filed for the child.
- The child (baby) does not have the status of residence for longer than three months.
 - * Not eligible to receive the special cash payment (¥100,000) 😒

• May 20 The rule in Japan changed.

- The child (baby) whose status of residence is for shorter than three months can receive the special cash payment (¥100,000).
- Apply for the special cash payment at a city hall.

 \rightarrow Receive the special cash payment (¥100,000) !
