September 15th ~ November 15th, 2021

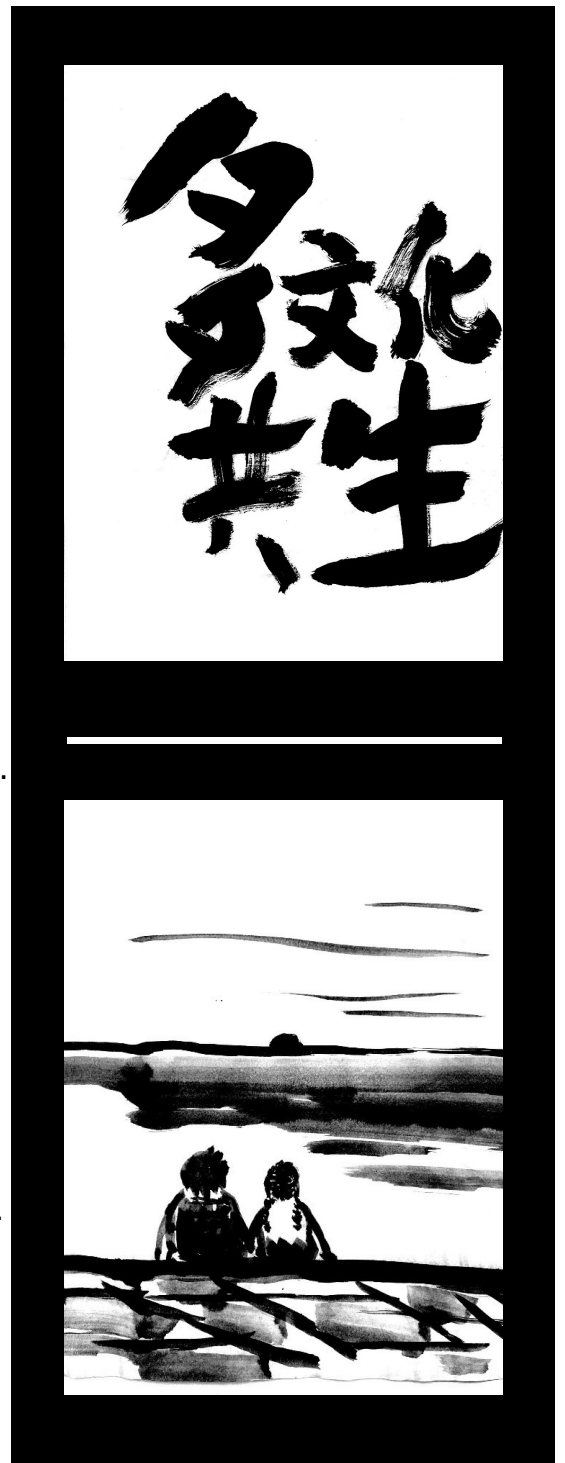
— Prize Money —

• Express your "Free Your Heart of Borders" in calligraphy (you can use any language) or in ink brush painting



- Please use calligraphy paper (HANSHI-paper : 25cm×34cm)
- You can use any kind of brush
- You must use black ink

You can get them at supermarket or 100 yen store.

- You need to write artwork description in 5 sentences or less
- You can write the descriptions in any of the 8 languages listed below.

- You can submit up to 2 artworks

※ Please send by post or bring in your artwork(s) to SPIRA after you fill out the application form online.

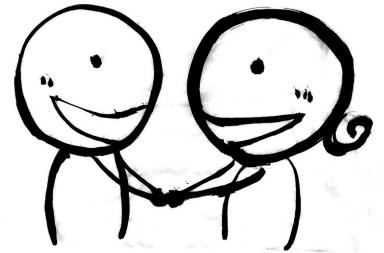
